Several night sky events to take in this month



NEEL ROBERTS Sky's the Limit

On Sunday, Jan. 10 look southwest after sundown and you'll see Venus, Pluto, Mercury, Saturn, Jupiter and Neptune in line. You'll need a telescope for Neptune and Pluto, but the other planets can be seen without one. On Thursday, Jan. 21 look west before 1:30 a.m. to see

west before 1:30 a.m. to see
Mars and the moon set into the
night.

On Friday, Jan. 29 look southeast before the sun rises to view Jupiter rise with the sun. You will need a good solar filter with binoculars or a telescope to see this.
