

# This month in the night sky

## **SKY WATCH**

Did you catch the Zodiacal Light last month? It's a faint, roughly triangular, whitish glow seen in the night sky extended up from the vicinity of the sun along the ecliptic or zodiac. The best time to see it this month is from Thursday, March 9 for two weeks in the west after the evening twilight.

The clocks advance an hour on Sunday, March 12, when daylight saving time begins.

Spring Equinox arrives on Monday, March 20 at 9:24 p.m. The days are getting noticeably longer.

On Tuesday, March 28, look up after sunset as Mars and a quarter waxing Moon will be up all night.
